- TSA members learn through exciting competitive events and leadership opportunities. From engineers to business managers, alumni credit TSA with a positive influence on their lives.



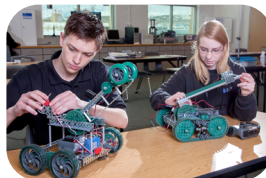

TSA PROFILE

TSA has members in middle schools and high schools in 49 states.

TSA has more than 70 middle school and high school competitions for use in a traditional classroom and virtually for distance learning.

TSA approximates that 100 percent of its members are likely to graduate and 75 percent of its members are college bound.

There are 3,500 TSA teachers/advisors throughout the U.S. TSA helps teachers meet the criteria for STEM education goals through exciting programs that include technology activities, competitions, leadership and teamwork for students.
