STPD Funding Plan:

The funds will be distributed to 21 LEA Title VI program sites. The plan and purpose of the Title VI STPD is to support and sustain the various Professional Learning (PL) activities for faculty, staff, students, parents, and Tribal Leaders. This includes Professional Learning, costs for materials, books, supplies, and conferences associated with the event. This may include costs for travel, lodging, meals for consultants, stipends for presenters, and keynote speakers. The funding may also include attending leadership training, general workshops, local and national conferences such as the National Indian Education Conference. Also, to engage in activities that help native language development, native culture activities, college and career preparation, parent participation and engagement, Native Tribal partnership, and any events that will enhance the students' progress in school.

Cost Not Covered with STPD Funds:

The funds may **not** be used to purchase food, snacks or beverages for any events, incentives for students, families, and the community (e.g., gift cards, treats, amusement, etc.).
