



PUPIL TRANSPORTATION RESTRICTIONS

- Utah Code 53-8-S211.5 an education entity may not use a vehicle with a seating capacity of 11 or more, including the driver, for the transportation of students unless the vehicle meets federal school bus safety standards.
 - -An LEA may use a vehicle but not for transporting students.
 - -Activity buses and Multi Purpose buses built to meet the FMVSS may be used for non to and from school transportation.
- Vehicles with greater than 16 passengers including the driver require a CDL license

UTAH HIGHWAY PATROL SCHOOL BUS INSPECTIONS

- Inspection and acceptance testing within 90 days of delivery.
- Out of service criteria and school bus defects
- Spring and fall school bus inspections.
 - -Fall 100% of fleet
 - -Spring 20% of fleet

SCHOOL BUS MAINTENANCE

Maintenance records should contain the following items:

- Line setting tickets;
- Work orders and repair records;
- Preventive maintenance records;
- Vehicle depreciation;
- Equipment specifications; and
- Inspection reports.
 - All commercial vehicles in Utah require an annual safety inspection

CDL REQUIREMENTS

You must have a Commercial Drivers License (CDL) to operate:

- Any single vehicle with a gross vehicle weight rating (GVWR) of 26,001 pounds or more.
- A vehicle designed to transport 16 or more passengers (including the driver).

You are required to have a class B CDL with Passenger and School bus endorsement to drive a school bus with 16 or more passengers (including the driver).

UTAH STATE STANDARDS SCHOOL BUS DRIVER QUALIFICATIONS

Standards for Utah School Buses and Operation – 2019 Pages 20-21

Bus Driving Qualifications – 26 requirements including the following;

- Background checks
- Driving history
- Felony and Criminal convictions
- Drug test
- Physical requirements
- Drug disclosure form

SCHOOL BUS DRIVER REQUIREMENTS

- CDL license with passenger and school bus endorsement
- Department of Transportation (DOT) physical examination at least every two years
- Physical Assessment Standard
- Maintain certification requirements
- Must be enrolled in a random drug testing program

DRIVER'S VEHICLE INSPECTION REPORT

- Pre-trip inspection
- Post-trip inspection
- En-route inspection

Documentation must be filled out for the post-trip inspection. It is best practice to have drivers to document the pre-trip inspection and verify that the bus passes the inspection, has not been tampered with and is safe to drive.

• I5-Hour On-Duty Limit


• The first limit is the **15-hour on-duty limit**. Following 8 consecutive hours off duty, you must not drive a commercial motor vehicle after being on duty 15 hours. You may do other work after being on duty 15 hours, but you may not drive.

• 10-Hour Driving Limit

The second limit is the driving limit. You are allowed 10 hours of driving time after 8 consecutive hours off duty. There is no limit on how many of those hours you are allowed to drive at one time — you may drive for as little as a few minutes or as much as 10 hours in a row. Once you have driven a total of 10 hours, you have reached the driving limit and must be off duty for another 8 consecutive hours before driving a commercial motor vehicle again.

DRIVER LOG BOOKS

School bus drivers must fill out a drivers log when they drive outside a 100 air-mile radius of your normal work reporting location.







- It is required that all school bus technicians receive eight hours of annual in-service
- All technicians shall maintain air brake and safety inspection certification
- Recommended Training
