

# WORLD LANGUAGES ENDORSEMENT SPECIFICATIONS

This endorsement may be attached to a current Professional or Associate Educator License with a Secondary Education area of concentration and is required to be qualified to teach any world language course with a secondary course code. The corequisite Dual Language Immersion (DLI) endorsement qualifies one to teach DLI.

The following world languages are available: Arabic, Chinese, Farsi, French, German, Hindi, Italian, Japanese, Korean, Latin, Portuguese, Russian, Samoan, Spanish, Tongan, Turkish. For other languages, please contact the World Languages Specialist.

## Only one demonstration of competency needed per requirement area.

Associate endorsement: Must meet areas 1 and 2.

#### Instructions for Completing the Application

- 1. All applications must include original documentation of completing the requirements for the desired language.
- 2. All applications must include official documentation of passing either the ACTFL OPI or the OPIc Proficiency Test at the Advanced-Low level or higher, taken within the last five years.

8. Read the welcome page, proctor & location information.

9. Select the test you want to be certified in (verify the required test to obtain your Utah DLI endorsement).

10. Now you can finish the registration process.
