


# School LAND Trust Program

## Annual Statewide Distribution 2023-2024

The School LAND Trust Program, established by the legislature in 1999, distributes a portion of the annual earnings from the permanent State School Fund through districts and charter schools to all public schools in the state. School Community Councils or Charter Trust Land Councils in each school prepare a plan to address the school's greatest academic needs with the distribution. Local School Boards and Charter Authorizing Agencies approve the plans in the spring, and schools with approved plans receive funding in the summer for the next school year. Plans for the upcoming school year and reports on expenditures and plan implementation are reviewed by school boards annually. Funding for the program flows through the local education agency business administrators and goes through the same audit procedures as other school funding.

Average Distribution for the 2022-2023 School Year

The average per pupil distribution is \$150.27.

The distribution formula is primarily based on student enrollment with a factor that advantages smaller districts and schools.
