

The **Statewide Online Education Program** (SOEP) allows students in grades 6-12 to take up to six credits per school year through an approved online school. The program:

- Provides access to quality, online learning anywhere.
- Utilizes technology to customize education to a student's learning style and pace.
- Allows students to customize their schedules to meet their academic goals.

Student Eligibility

A variety of student groups in grades 6-12 are <u>eligible to participate</u>.

Create a Counselor SEATS Account

Each counselor needs to set up an account in SEATS to accept or reject student course selections. Please note that if a counselor changes schools, or has other significant changes, they should email <u>edonline@schools.utah.gov</u> to have their account updated.
