It will be either May 15th or May 20th. Please note any requests on the SEATS CCA main page.</p>

If you are accepting CCAs individually, you will find the "Course Start Date" box next to the "Status" box. For bulk acceptance of CCAs, use the "Start Date" box to input the course start date.</p> <p>SSID and SEATS status change: If a provider attempts to make a status change on a CCA and the SSID number is missing, the following message will appear: "SSID is missing. Please update in order to change status." The provider must then enter the missing SSID number to complete the status change.</p> <p>SSID and SEATS account: If a student doesn't provide an SSID number when creating a SEATS account, it <i>will not</i> prevent them from creating the account. Providers will input an SSID for private and homeschool students and USBE will input the number for public students when they have obtained those numbers.</p> <p>Spring 2023-2024 Provider Check-in: In anticipation of our Spring 2023-2024 Provider Check-in, you can find the agenda in your calendar invitation.</p>
