2024-2025 Duties, Priorities, and Meeting Dates

Duties

- 1) Advise the Utah State Board of Education (USBE) of unmet needs within the State in the education of students with disabilities.
- 2) Comment publicly on any rules or regulations proposed for issuance by the State regarding the education of students with disabilities.
- 3) Advise the USBE in developing evaluations and reporting on data to the Secretary of the U.S. Department of Education under Section 618 of the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA).
- 4) Advise the USBE in developing corrective action plans to address findings identified in Federal monitoring reports under Part B of the IDEA.
- 5) Advise the USBE in developing and implementing policies relating to the coordination of services for students with disabilities.
- 6) Review and comment on completed due process hearing findings.
- 7) Advise the USBE on the risk ratio threshold for determining disproportionality.

- 3) Promote practices that support tailored learning approaches and meet diverse student needs, including processes that empower teachers by actively involving them in district-level policy decisions.
