

# Transition from Early Intervention



## Part B Responsibility Timeline

**Indicator 12 Preschool Transition** is part of the data states report annually to the Office of Special Education Programs (OSEP) via a federal report. This indicator is focused on preschool transitions from Part C (ages 0-3) to Part B (ages 3-22). This is a compliance indicator that requires 100% of students participating in early intervention/Part C who transition and are found eligible for Part B special education services have their Individual Education Program (IEP) implemented by their third birthday.

The expected timeline for a Local Education Agency (LEA) to follow is below:

27  
Months

**By the time the child is 27 months old:**

Notification sent to LEA through [Transition from Early Intervention Data Input \(TEDI\) System](#).

33  
Months

**By the time the child is 33 months old:**

Transition conference is held with Part C

33-36  
Months

**Between the time the child is 33-36 months old:**

Send Prior Written Notice (PWN) declining evaluation.

**OR**

Hold eligibility/Individual Education Program (IEP) meetings.

37  
Months

**By the time the child is 37 months old:**

LEA input all information into TEDI
