
## Decision Tree for Reporting Educational Environments for Students Ages 3–5 with IEPs

\*=Regular Early Childhood Program
A program that includes a majority (at least 50%) of students without disabilities (i.e., students not on IEPs).
This category may include, but is not limited to:

- Head Start
- Kindergarten (public or private)
- Preschool classes (public or private)
- Group child development center or child care

## ^=Separate Class

A special education classroom that includes a majority (at least 50%) of students with disabilities (i.e., students on IEPs). This category may include, but is not limited to, programs in:

- Regular school buildings
- Trailers/Portables
- Child care facilities
- Hospital facilities (out-patient)
- · Other community-based settings
